OPEN TO ALL



Only 25 minutes from Junction 27 of the M5 motorway. Easy access from A361.

From Tiverton - take the A361 (North Devon Link Road) and turn left at the turning for "Rackenford, Templeton & Loxbeare" (Stonelands Cross), approximately 7 miles from Tiverton. Turn right at T junction and continue for approx. 2.5 miles. Turn right for Knowstone and Molland and show site is ahead.

From South Molton – take the A361 and turn right at Knowstone Picnic Area (Moortown Cross), turn immediately left for Rackenford and follow this road for 2 miles, the show site is on the left, on a sharp right hand bend. WRC signs will be in place on the day from both routes off the A361 and from Rackenford village.

Rosettes to 10th place (entries permitting) plus best WRC member in each class.

CLASS 1 Introductory Test A 2008

Section A - Restricted to combinations that have not been placed $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ at Introductory level and riders not to have competed at affiliated dressage.

Section B – Open to all

CLASS 2 Preliminary 7 (2002)

Section A - Restricted to combinations that have not been placed $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ at Preliminary level and riders not to have competed at affiliated dressage.

Section B – Open to all

CLASS 3 Preliminary 13 (2006) - Open to all. WSDDC QUALIFIER

(Separate rosettes for under 16's, indicate eligibility on entry form).

CLASS 4 Novice 27 (2007) WSDDC QUALIFIER

CLASS 5 Pick a test – either Novice 34 (2009) OR Elementary 42 (2008)

ADVANCE ENTRIES ONLY FOR DRESSAGE . ENTRIES CLOSE 12 NOON Monday 10th June

SHOW JUMPING (All entries on the day) To start at 10.30 a.m.

ENTRY FEE (includes contribution to First Aid). WRC members £6 per class, non-members £7.

Please Note: If the first phase of the round is jumped clear, you immediately continue to the second phase of the round, against the clock. If you are not clear in the first phase, a bell will ring at the end of the first phase to signal that you should leave the arena and not continue to the timed second phase.

CLASS 8 70 cm (approx. 2'3in)

CLASS 9 75 cm (approx. 2ft 6in) Restricted to combinations not placed $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ in 75cm or above SJ,ODE

CLASS 9 75cm (approx 2ft 6in) Open to all (including those who have entered Class 8)

<u>CLASS 10</u> 80cm (approx.2ft 9in)

CLASS 11 90 cm (approx. 3ft) Foxdon Cup awarded to Best WRC member

CLASS 12 1m (approx. 3ft 3in)

In Classes 7 and 8, all clear first phase rounds will receive a rosette.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS - Anyone found not obeying these rules will not be allowed to compete.

- 1. The competition will be run according to BRC rules. A full copy may be seen at the secretary's trailer and these are also available on the BRC website.
- 2. By entering this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding and competing. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to safeguard the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards, in the interests of their own and the safety of others. Witheridge Riding Club, the landowners and officials will not accept any liability for any accident, loss, injury or damage to competitors, property, vehicles, animals or spectators of any description.
- 3. This event is covered by British Riding Clubs' insurance; however, competitors are advised to hold their own personal injury insurance cover and non RC members to hold third party cover.
- 4. Hats to current BRC Standards must be worn and securely fastened when mounted. Body protectors are advised for the show jumping.
- 5. All horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old. Horses or ponies can compete in a maximum of 2 dressage classes AND 2 SJ classes OR 3 of either.
- 6. All dogs must be kept on leads; children must be supervised at all times and are not allowed in SJ warm up.
- 7. Practice jumps must be jumped with the red flag to the right and NO cantering outside warm-up.
- 8. Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves on time for each class.
